Justice V Khalid commemorates

The High Court Judge, Justice A Mohammed Mushtaq inaugurated the "Justice V Khalid Commemoration" under the auspices of Sir Syed College Alumni Association on Sunday, December 17, 2017. High Court Judge, Justice A Mohammed Mushtaq said in his speech that Justice Khalid was an educationalist and reformist, who was born into a typical North Malabar family and rose to the heights with his own hard work, knowledge and ability. Modern education in the Muslim community of North Malabar began with the establishment of Sir Syed College under the auspices of the CDMEA. As the college was named Sir Syed, in honor of Sir Syed Ahmed Khan, He urged to establish a Law College, under the auspices of the CDMEA in his name, as a memorial of gratitude and to keep the memory of Justice V Khalid alive. Sir Syed College Alumni Association President C V Jayachandran presided over the function. District Judges Kausar Edappakkath, K Soman, K Abdul Kader, Prof. AD Mustafa, Principal Abdul Aziz, Former Principal Khalil Chovva, Adv. Mahmood, Allamkulam Mahmood, Meera Shan, Adv. Kerala Floods

Our state experienced unprecedented floods during this monsoon. The magnitude of destruction caused by the recent, unprecedented floods that hit kerala is beyond expression. Nearly one sixth of the Population was directly affected by the floods and related incidents. All the infrastructure facility were heavily damaged and destructed. Lakhs of people were stranded and were waiting on the roof tops without food, medicine and rescue. There were about 45 relief centers in Kannur district alone. Nearly 50 lives were lost.

Properties severely damaged. Thousands of people lost their houses and became homeless. Roads washed off. People were in short of basic needs. Words cannot describe the pain and agony experienced by people. All the Panchayaths of Kannur Districts were affected and Pattuvam, Ezhome, Madayi, Mattool, Kannapuram, Cherukunnu, Pappinisseri, Irikkur, Kurumathur, Chengalayi, Malappattam, Sreekandapuram, Padiyur and Chemberi were heavily affected. Houses and shops of many Alumni Members were submerged and they were in relief camps with their families. Our members suffer huge financial loss due to inundation of water into their house and shop. The people and the Government rose to the situation. Rescue activity, supply of basic requirements and financial assistance all were of appreciable standards. Rebuilding Kerala is not an easy task even though the State is committed to it. Our alumni members contributed substantially to the Chief Ministers Kerala Flood Relief Fund. Our alumni members also contributed through Residence associations, Schools, various political and social organizations. Apart from all these our members religiously responded to the call given by the Sir Syed College Alumni Association.

Sir Syed College Alumni Association gave a call to the members for immediate support. All the Regional Chapters gave their spontaneous support and Alumni Association was able to collect flood relief materials worth of 5 Lakhs within a period of 4 Days and distributed the relief materials to Relief Centers through respective Regional Chapter Leadership.

Constitution Amendment 2019

Since 2015, efforts have been made to amend the existing constitution. The current constitution amendment was ratified by the General Body of Life Members, which met on June 6, 2019.

Major Amendments and Changes:

1. All Office Bearers should be Life Members and the electorate shall be Life Members of the SSCAA.
2. The Regional, Departmental, Staff, PDC Batch, Chapter, NCC, NSS and Overseas Association can be formed within and outside India subject to the approval and concurrence from the parent organization. All activities of Regional, Departmental, Staff, PDC Batch, Chapter, NCC, NSS and Overseas Association should conduct to uphold the dignity of the parent Chapter.
3. The elected officers of the Alumni Association shall be one President, five Vice Presidents, a General Secretary, five Secretaries and a Treasurer. They shall be elected from among the Life Members in Life Members General Body Meeting of the Association for a term of two years. The term of all the elected officers shall be concurrent.
4. The Principal of the College shall be the Official Patron of the Association. He shall be the permanent Invitee of all the body.
5. Immediate Past-President and Immediate Past-General Secretary: When a new President and new General Secretary is elected, the Past-President and Past General Secretary shall serve in an advisory capacity, an ex-officio officer of the Association for the next coming term.

6. Membership of the Executive Committee shall consist of the following Members

- a) The officers of Alumni Association.
- b) Twenty members elected by the Alumni Association from among Life members.
- c) All Regional Chapter Presidents.
- d) The Principal, Immediate Past-President and Immediate Past-General Secretary
- e) The Staff Alumni President.
- f) All Departmental, NSS & NCC Alumni Presidents.

7. Quorum: 10 members shall constitute a quorum of the Executive Committees. In the event of shortage of Quorum in the next meeting the members present shall constitute the Quorum.

8. No office-bearers i.e., President, Vice-Presidents, General Secretary, Secretaries and Treasurer shall hold any of these office for more than two terms continuously (Block years) i.e. for a period of 4(four) years. He / She may continue in the Executive Committee. A member of the Executive Committee may, however, seek office after a lapse of one term (two years) to any of the above-mentioned Five posts.

9. The Alumni Council shall consist of the following members.

- a) Members of the Executive Committee of Alumni Association.
- b) The President, Secretary and one Alumni Councilor from each Region, Departmental, Staff, PDC Batch, Chapter, NCC, NSS and Over Seas Alumni Association, may nominate their constituents from their respective areas in case, they are unable to attend any meeting.
- c) All Past Presidents & Gen. Secretaries.
- d) 5 Special Invitees from Rtd. Teachers.
- e) 5 Present Teachers.
- f) 2 Rtd. Non Teaching Staffs.
- g) 2 Present Non Teaching Staffs.
- h) 20 Alumni Council members from Life Members.

shall be selected by the Executive Committee of the Alumni Association from the Life Members in its first or second Executive meeting and shall hold office for two year only.

10. Quorum: 30 members shall constitute a quorum of the Alumni Council. In the event of shortage of Quorum in the next meeting the members present shall constitute the Quorum.

11. The Regional, Departmental, Staff, PDC Batch, Chapter, NCC, NSS and Overseas Association shall have the following office bearers who shall be elected by the Regional, Departmental, Staff, PDC Batch, Chapter, NCC, NSS and Overseas Association once in two years. All Office Bearers should be Life Members.

- (i) President
- (ii) Two Vice Presidents
- (iii) Secretary
- (iv) Three joint Secretaries
- (v) Treasurer
- (vi) Alumni Council Member
- (vii) 10 Executive Committee Members.

12. The Life Members General Body meeting of the Alumni Association shall ordinarily be held before 2nd October, Occurring every Two years.

13. Quorum: Fifty or 1/3 of members present, whichever is less constitute a quorum at any Annual or special Life Members Meeting of the Association. In the case of shortage in quorum for a meeting the members present shall constitute the quorum of the next meeting.

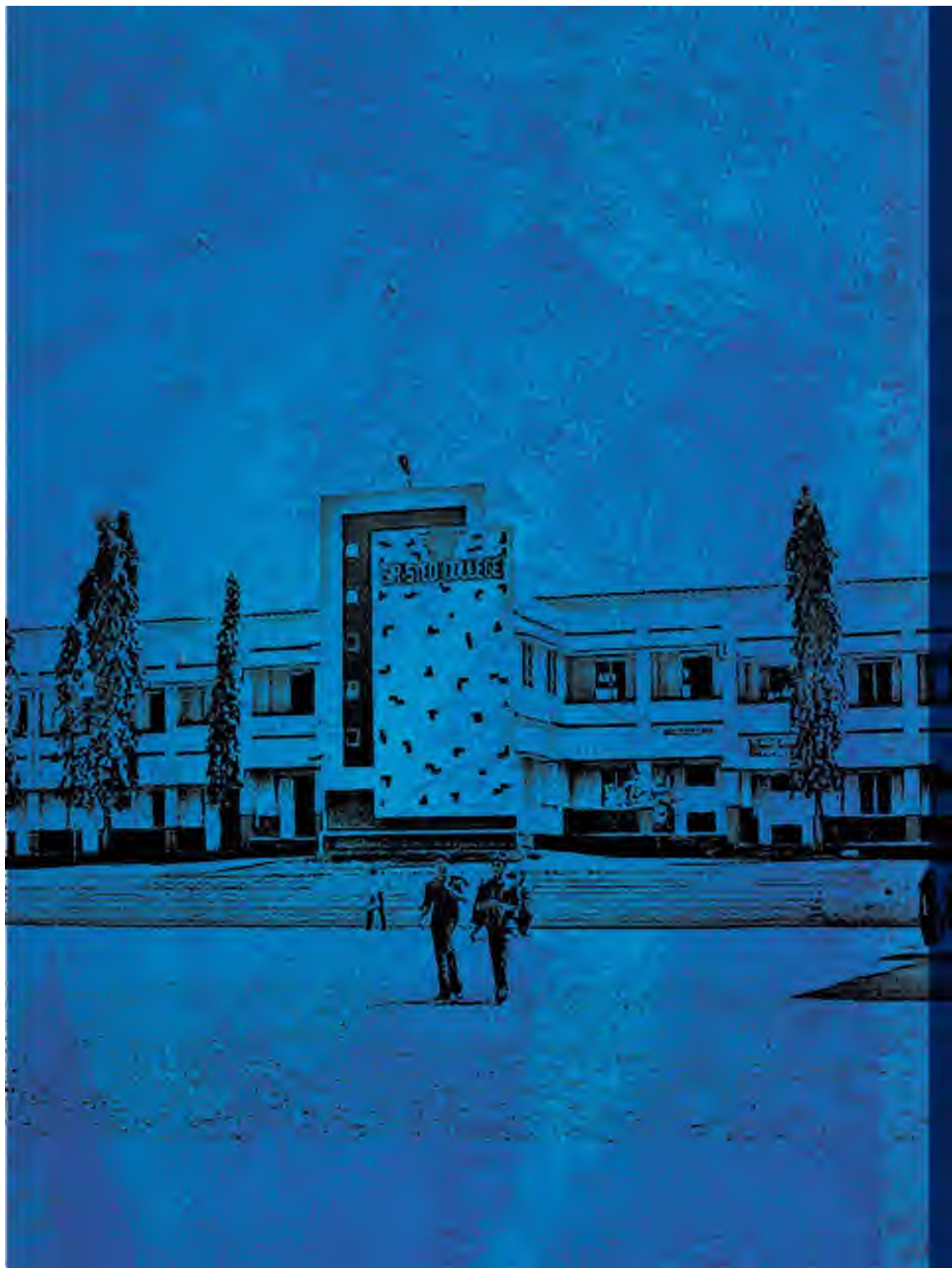
