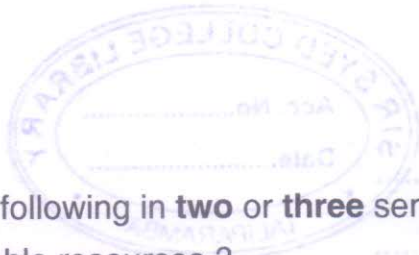
- 3) Explain different types of biodiversity and elaborate on their evolution. How does human activity influence biodiversity ?

- 10) What are the two world views on environment reflected in Chief Seattle’s speech ? (4×4=16)

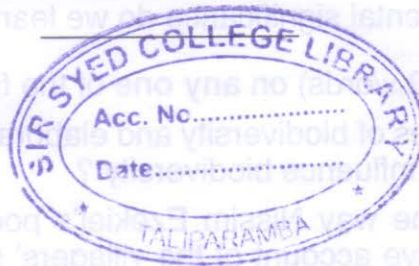
