Achiever's Talk

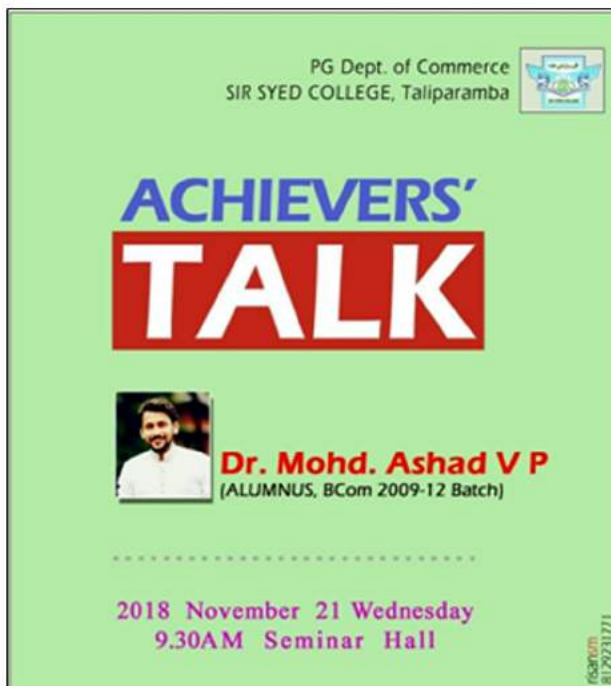

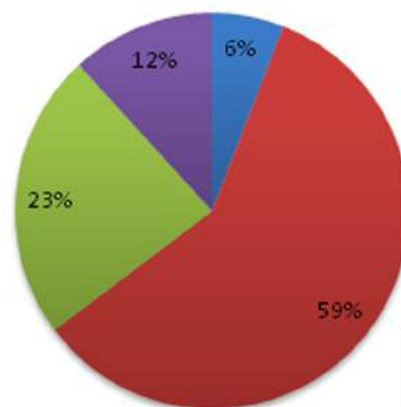

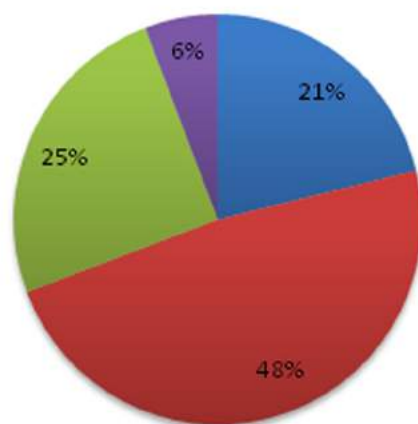

Thusharagiri, Calicut
