STUDY TOUR TO OOTY

The Department of History organized a study tour for its fifth-semester students on August 2, 2025. The tour was a significant academic event, providing students with a practical and enriching experience beyond the traditional classroom setting. A total of 43 students participated in the tour, comprising 9 boys and 34 girls. The excursion was designed to offer a multifaceted learning experience by visiting several locations that hold historical and cultural importance.

MINOROOTTY 2.0

The Department of History, Sir Syed College, Taliparamba, organized a one-day Learning Expedition titled minorootty 2.0 on 1st November 2025. The program was specially designed for the FYUGP Minor students of History of Tourism Studies as a practical learning experience to explore the historical and cultural dimensions of tourism.
