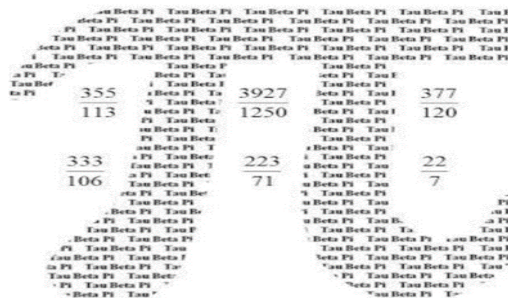

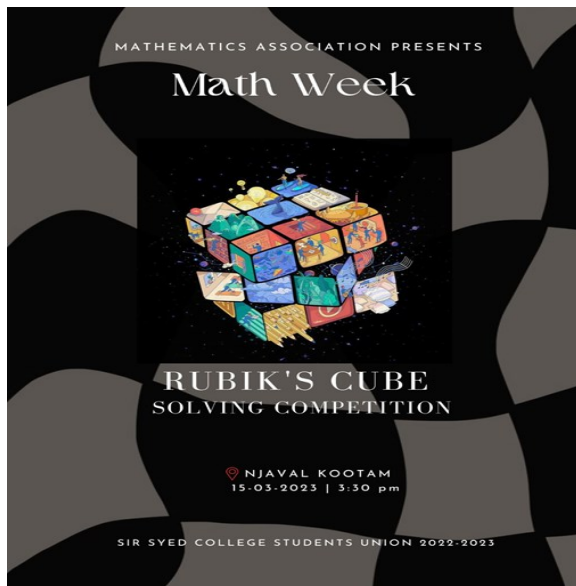
Human calculator competition

- Mubashira ,Sixth semester BSc Mathematics



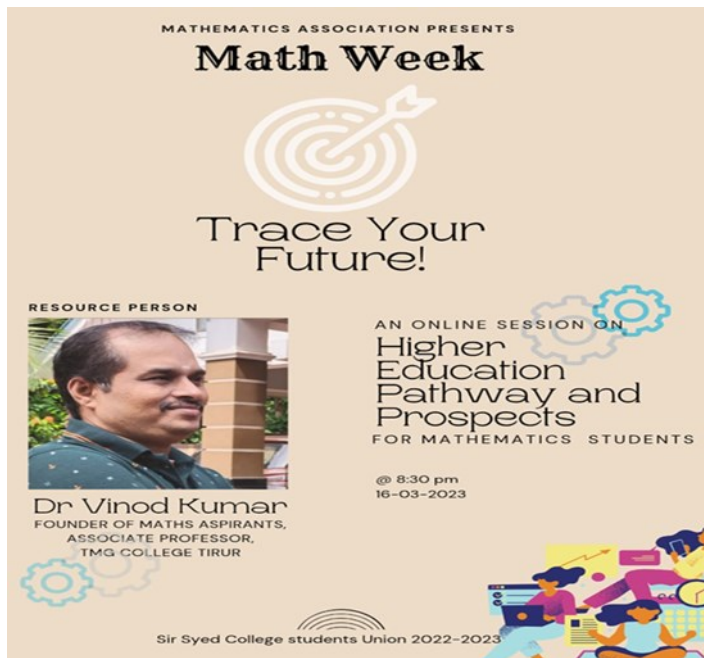
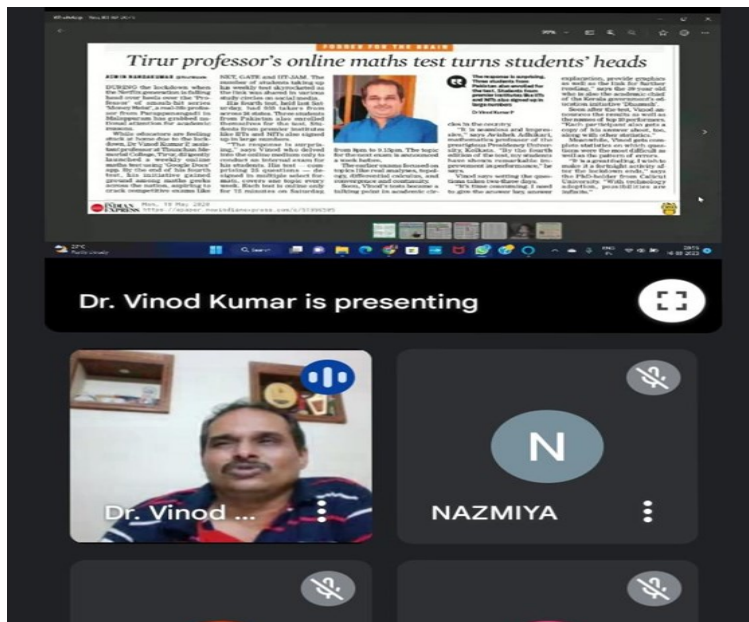
RUBIKS CUBE COMPETITION
