## “പേജുകൾക്കപ്പുറം”: Sir Syed College Celebrates National Reading Day

In observance of National Reading Day, the Department of Journalism at Sir Syed College, Taliparamba, organized a vibrant literary programme titled “പേജുകൾക്കപ്പുറം” (Beyond the Pages) on 19 June 2026 at Njaval Koottam. The event aimed to promote a robust reading culture among students and nurture their creative and literary talents.

The programme commenced at 3:00 PM with a welcome address by Shahana T.P., a BJMC student. The event featured dedicated sessions celebrating literature through guest speakers, reading experiences, book reviews, and poetry recitation. A major highlight of the afternoon was the interactive session with special student-guests: student-authors Safa Khalid and Fathimath Shifa (both second-year B.Sc. Chemistry students), alongside Fathima Ziya T.P., an alumna of the Department of Journalism. Safa introduced her three published books, discussing her inspiration and creative drive, while Fathimath Shifa and Fathima Ziya T.P. shared their personal insights and journeys as writers, beautifully showcasing the institution's commitment to fostering literary creativity. Following this, an engaging "Experience Sharing" segment took place, where Nafla (Mathematics), Nafla (Statistics), and Sadaani Zubair (English) shared their meaningful personal reflections on how reading has shaped their perspectives.

This paved the way for a lively book review session where students from various disciplines critically analyzed major literary works. Among the reviewers: Saniha Das (Journalism) reviewed Anuragalolagathri. Rushda (Journalism) analyzed Franz Kafka's classic *The Metamorphosis*. Farsana C. (English) presented *The Kite Runner* by Khaled Hosseini. Fathima P. (English) reviewed Paulo Coelho's *The Alchemist*. Shaza (B.Com) shared her insights on *Ettavum Priyapetta Ennodu*. Adding a beautiful artistic layer to the celebration, Ziya Zinoz, a BJMC student, performed a captivating poem recitation of Rudyard Kipling's famous poem, *The Fabulists*. The event, meticulously coordinated by Shahana, concluded with inspiring addresses by journalism faculty members Muhammed Niyas and Muhammed Ladeed, who highlighted the enduring value of literature and the necessity of lifelong reading habits. Following a heartfelt vote of thanks by BJMC student Abdul Samad, the highly successful programme drew to a close at around 5:00 PM, leaving the audience deeply inspired to explore new literary horizons.
