





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into at Kannur, Taliparamba on 13th September 2023.

BETWEEN:

ISDC Projects India Pvt. Ltd, trading as "ISDC - International Skill Development Corporation" and having its Regional Office at Lakshmi Narayan Complex, Palace Road, Vasanth Nagar, Bengaluru, Karnataka – 560052, represented by its Regional Head Mr. Sharath Venugopal, hereinafter referred to as "ISDC" or FIRST PARTY.


AND

Sir Syed College, an affiliated college under Kannur University conducting Graduate and Post Graduate courses; having its premises at Kannur India, represented by its Principal Dr Ismail Olayikkara, here in after referred to as "Sir Syed College" or SECOND PARTY

Both Parties have been working together since the year 2023 and have expressed a desire of entering a Memorandum of Understanding to continue the partnership to meettheir respective objectives, which are set out herein below.

WHEREAS

a. The First Party - ISDC, a Skill Development & Education Company having expertise in Professional and Vocational Education and is interested in associating with the Second Party to promote ISDC's ACCA Professional Qualification Pathway through BSc International Finance, validated by the Queen Margaret University in the UK; which is accredited by ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants); the Global Body for Professional






Accountants. The Accreditation allows students to avail 9 exemptions against the ACCA Professional Qualification and complete the same by writing 4 examinations.

b. The Second Party - Sir Syed college; on its part is interested in associating with First Party to provide opportunities for its B. Com/BBA or any other degree 2nd Year Completed Students to access the ISDC' ACCA Professional Qualification Pathway through BSc International Finance, validated by the Queen Margaret University in the UK which helps students to access ACCA Professional Qualification along with their Undergraduate Degree.

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to set forth the terms and conditions under which the Parties to this understanding shall conduct themselves during the subsistence of the Memorandum.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is not intended to be, legally binding except as specifically set out below.

- 1. The First Party shall support the Second Party to promote the ISDC' ACCA Professional Qualification Pathway and the students enrolled for this can access ACCA Professional Qualification along with their Undergraduate Degree.
- 2. The First Party can use the name of the Second Party for promoting this Partnership. The Second Party can also use the name of First Party for advertisements and promotional purposes.
- 3. The admission criteria and the number of seats for the above said program are fixed by the parties mutually, however in line with the Eligibility Criteria set by the Queen Margaret University.
- 4. The First Party facilitates train the trainer program to the Faculties of the Second Party as per mutually agreed time schedule to deliver ACCA oriented training. 3





- The First Party provides a digital version of the relevant Learning Materials to the students enrolled and ISDC shall offer placement assistance for the students on their successful completion of ACCA Professional Qualification.
- 6. The First Party provides additional training support/ master classes to the students enrolled for ACCA and the number of hours per subject / per module is given in Annexure 1.

OR

The First Party provides additional training support/ master classes to the students enrolled for ACCA and the number of hours per subject / per module is given in Annexure 1. If the number of students enrolled for the program is less than 12, the training will be done through Online Mode by using the LMS of the First Party.


- 7. All responsibilities regarding registration of the students with Queen Margaret University (QMU) and ACCA should be dealt with, by the First Party. The students have to follow the Rules and Regulations of QMU and ACCA to appear the examination and pursue the qualification/membership and designation.
 - The relevant fee to ACCA has to be paid by the students directly as per the rules and regulations set by the ACCA time to time as per Annexure II.
 - 9. The First Party shall collect a per student fee from the Second Party as per the table below:

INR 90,000 Per Student for the Whole Course Fees to be paid in 2 installments.

- INR 50,000 to be payable at the time of admission.
- INR 40,000 to be payable within 3 months.




- ii. The Specified commercials does not include GST or any other tax components.
- iii. The mentioned fee to be collected by the College of; ISDC will invoice College, based on the number of students enrolled for the course.
- 10. The complete list of Students of the course shall be provided to the First Party by the Second Party. Changes in Students, if any, shall be communicated by the representative of the Second Party to the First Party immediately.
- 11. It is intended that the terms of this MoU will remain in force for a period of three years set out above i.e., the completion of First Batch or is otherwise terminated in accordance with the provisions of Clause (12). The MoU can be extended for further periods after the expiry of three years upon the parties mutually agreeing such extension in writing. The terms of this Memorandum may be modified at any time by both parties on mutual consent.
- 12. Either Party shall be entitled to terminate the MOU on 60 days' notice. The MoU will automatically terminate:
 - Any potential Binding Agreement would be unenforceable, void or illegal due to any statutory or regulatory requirements; or
 - Terminates any Binding Agreement for cause.
 - In the event of the termination of the agreement, the First Party agrees to complete the existing batches on agreed terms.
 - 13. All Intellectual Property created by a Party in connection with the collaboration shall remain the property of that Party. The Parties agree that any material jointly created by the Parties for the collaboration shall be jointly owned (based on the Contributions) by the Parties, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
 - 14. Where the collaboration reasonably requires the use by one Party of Intellectual Property that is owned by the other Party (the "IPR Owner"), the IPR Owner will license such rights to





the other Party on a non-exclusive basis, without the right to sub-license, solely for the purpose and to the extent necessary in connection with the collaboration. Any such license will automatically terminate when the MoU is terminated.

- 15. For the purposes of this MoU, "Confidential Information" shall be all information of a confidential nature (whether written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of either Party which is obtained or received as a result of the discussions leading up to, the entering into or the performance of this MoU, including Financial Information, Training & Learning Material, Trade Secrets, University / College Lists, Trade and Commercial Details and Computer Software and Databases, the Contents of all Reports and Documentation prepared by either Party or on its behalf and any other information of a confidential nature designated by a Party as confidential; Each of the Parties shall at all times while this MoU remains in force and after it has terminated, keep confidential the Confidential Information except where:
 - The Confidential Information was already lawfully known, or became lawfully known to either of the Parties independently.
 - Disclosure or use is necessary by either of the Parties (including their employees, agents and sub-contractors) for the proper and effective performance of this MoU;
 - Disclosure is required by law to any Government, Governmental Department, Agency,
 Regulatory or Fiscal Body or Authority (whether national or foreign) and their
 Authorized Agents (including professional advisers);
 - The Confidential Information is disclosed, in the case of ISDC, to another member of the ISDC Group of Companies.
 - Each Party undertakes to the other that it will not disclose or make use of, for its own benefit, any of the Confidential Information of that other Party.





16. All disputes and differences of any kind whatever arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be referred to the arbitration as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and in case of any disputes not settled due to arbitration it will be subject to the courts of Bangalore Jurisdiction.

The expression party of the First Part and the Party of second part shall unless the context otherwise requires be deemed to mean and include their representatives, successors and assigns.

THE WESTERN INDIA PLYWOODS Ltd and PG Department of Commerce, Sir Syed College shall hereinafter also collectively be referred to as the "Parties" and individually as the "Party".

Whereas

- The Western India Plywoods Ltd is a company with the sole objective of export marketing timbers thereby creating employment leading to economic and social development of Malabar.
- PG Department of Commerce, Sir Syed College is affiliated to Kannur University.
- The Western India Plywoods Ltd and PG Department of Commerce Sir Syed College
 are desirous of entering into an agreement to work together in supporting student
 community to enter in the field of marketing and business.
- 4. The parties appreciate each other's objective in promoting excellence, inter alia, in entrepreneurship in common areas of interest and are desirous of entering into an agreement for the aforesaid purpose. The Parties are also desirous of working together for identifying other areas of co-operation between them.

- The parties hereto are fully desirous of recording the terms of their agreement into this
 agreement for the areas identified for co-operation and commit to co-operate.
- The parties consider that this Agreement must be implemented diligently and in good faith, with due regard for each party's legitimate concerns

2. Objective

The parties have agreed to work together with the prime objective of promoting and inculcating entrepreneurial skills among the students of the college. The development of leadership and marketing skills of students is also a key objective.

3. Scope of the Agreement

Based on the terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon between the parties from time to time, both the parties agreed.

4. Project Coordinator

5. Rights and Obligations of the Parties

5.1 Rights and Obligation of First Party;

- 5.1.2 To provide access to the programmes conducted by The Western India Plywoods Ltd if required.
- 5.1.3 To allow the department for conducting industrial visits to the premises of first party.
 - 5.1.4 To motivate students for startups.
 - 5.1.5 To provide internship facility for students if required.
- 5.1.6 To conduct programmes for the development of entrepreneurial skill of the students.

5.2 Rights and Obligations of Second Party

- 5.2.1 To conduct startup workshop with the support of The Western India Plywoods Ltd.
 - 5.2.2 To promote entrepreneurship culture among students
 - 5.2.3 To conduct programmes in association of the First Party.

Key Points

- ♣ Target group consists of 60 70 students.
- 4 Department students will get chance to visit the company once in a year in between the months of August and March.
- Maximum of five students will get chance to do their projects annually.
- Mutual cooperation is possible between the parties in the areas of placement, entrepreneurship development, etc.
- ♣ All possible programmes can be conducted with the consultation and the confirmation of the both parties from time to time.

7. Amendment and Waiver

This agreement may be amended, modified, superseded or cancelled, and any of the terms, covenants, representations, warranties, or condition hereof may be waived, only by a written instrument signed and executed by the respective duly authorized representative of each of the parties hereto. Further, any waiver of any of the terms hereof shall be valid if made by mutual consent of the parties.

- The students enrolled for this add-on course leads to the additional qualification from
 First party / Membership from the respective professional organization only for the
 candidates appearing and clearing CPC Examination.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the First Party to get the necessary accreditations from the professional body (AAPC). The final approved syllabus by AAPC for the add-on course with the exemptions availed from professional bodies through program accreditation process will be given as Annexure 1 (Syllabus).
- Second Party agrees to provide all infrastructure necessary to conduct the course at the
 premises of the Institution and the first party agrees to conduct all offline classes of the
 add-on course at the assigned location only.
- 4. The Second Party shall nominate a point of contact (POC) for co-ordination of this programme.
- 5. The admission criteria, after the approval by the first party is stated in Annexure 3. The same shall be upheld for shortlisting all applicants. The number of seats for the above said program are fixed by the Second Party. The complete list of students of the course shall be provided to the First Party by the Second Party. Changes in students, if any, shall be communicated by the representative of the Second Party to the First Party immediately.
- 6. The First Party facilitates necessary certified trainers, consulting, and technical support to the Second Party.
- Classroom teaching shall be fixed according to the schedule prepared by the first party and the second party jointly without causing inconvenience to the regular conduct of classes in the College.
- 8. The First Party provides Study materials as well as sufficient library copies for reference of all learning materials (For the subjects accredited by the professional body) to the students enrolled for the above said add on course.

 the best satisfaction of the students and Second Party as stated in the Academic
 Calendar
- 10. The mode of the class will be Offline and Minimum number of students will be 25 Nos.
- 11. The First Party provides exam-oriented training support to the students enrolled for the above add on course for their external examinations of the professional body. The number of hours per subject / paper/module as given in Annexure 2.
- 12. The students enrolled for the add on course are given the opportunity to attend the examinations of certificate in CPC of AAPC as a part of their program. The first party (Anton's Medicode) only provides the registration services to the students who are willing for CPC Examination and the amount is a separate payment which is done by the student through online site of AAPC.
- 13. Once the registration process is complete, the first party will provide 1 month CPC examination training prior to examination date only through online mode.
- 14. All responsibilities regarding registration of the students who are appearing for CPC Examination with the professional body should be dealt with by the First Party. The students must follow the rules and regulations of the respective professional body to appear for the examination and pursue the qualifications/memberships and designations.
- 15. The relevant fee to the professional body must be paid by the students directly as per the rules and regulations set by the professional body time to time as given in Annexure 2.
- 16. As per the schedule, courses must be completed by 5 months, duration of 100 hours weekly 5 hours, if any delays happening due to holidays or other issues First party have the right to complete the course through additional online hours, if necessary, in the above-mentioned time period.
- Classes for the students are scheduled classes only on Saturdays from morning 10 AM to 1 PM and 2 PM to 4 PM.
- 18. The students must obligatorily complete add-on course with 90% attendance, 70% marks in the final test conducted by the First party to get the course completion certificate provided by the first party.

- 19. Placement assistance will be provided only for the students who have completed their pursuing degree from the second party. The second party must provide the course completion certificate before conducting the interview.
- 20. The first party agrees to maintain bound and numbered Registers for the following which will be shared with Second party on request:
 - a. Register showing the names of students enrolled in the add-on course.
 - b. Register of Attendance of students, separate for each batch.
 - c. Register showing the receipt of fees and structure of fees, separate for each batch.
 - d. Register showing the Names, Age, Educational Qualification, Experience, and Date of joining of the faculty members.
 - e. Register of Attendance of the faculty members.
 - f. Attested copies of the Qualifications and Experience of the faculty members. The first party shall maintain the above registers and records up to date and shall make them available for inspection by authorized personnel of the second party. The second party or anyone authorized by it shall be entitled to conduct inspection of the above records as well as the premises of the Institution on any normal working day/hours without any prior intimation to the Institution.
- 21. This is for the student's during the academic year 2023-2024. The course fees can be revised if mutually agreed by the two parties. If the first party is found levying course fees from the students at rates exceeding that agreed upon by the second party or adopting any unfair means in fee collection, the first party shall be liable to endure legal action taken up by the second party.

- 22. Use of name or logo of Sir Syed College, Karimbam, Taliparamba, Kannur, Kerala 670142 in displays, advertisements or promotions shall be done by First Party with the prior approval of Second Party only and Second Party will not bear any liability whatsoever for any issue arising out of that.
- 23. The duration of the agreement shall be a minimum of one year; however, the same may be renewed further on mutual consent of both the parties. Both parties reserve the right to terminate the MoU agreement, if it is found that the other party has indulged in any malpractice or has violated any of the conditions and guidelines of operation.
- 24. Both parties have the right to terminate the MOU on 60 days prior notice.
- 25. The First party shall hold the second party's interest's paramount, without any consideration for future work, and strictly avoid conflict of interest with other assignments or their own interests. If during the period of this contract, a conflict of interest arises for any reason, the first party shall promptly disclose the same to the second party and seek its instructions.
- 26. Disputes arising out of this agreement shall as far as possible be settled by the parties directly. In case of disagreement, the same shall be subjected to the provision of Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation (Amended) Act, 2015
- 27. In the event of the termination of the agreement, the First Party agrees to complete the existing batches on the agreed terms contained in this MOU.
- 28. Neither party shall be liable to the other for any delay or failure on its part in performing any of its obligations under this agreement, resulting from any cause beyond its control, including but not limited to strikes, fires, floods, earthquakes, explosions, riots, acts of Governments, war or enemy action, provided the same is issued in writing to the other party within 15 days of such incident.

WHEREAS:

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS

1. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

WT

The publications shall also provide appropriate authorship to the WTI personnel involved in the project.
- 3.3. These shall be decided in mutual consent of WTI and the COLLEGE before the initiation of any project.
- 3.4. The COLLEGE shall provide one copy of the research report to WTI and WTI shall provide one copy of the research project done at the COLLEGE by the bonafide candidate of WTI.

4. TERM & TERMINATION

- 4.1. This Agreement shall be effective from 05th June 2023 and shall be valid for a period of twenty-four months *i.e.* till 04th June 2025.
- 4.2. The term of this Agreement may be further extended for such period and on such terms as the Parties may mutually decide in writing. This Agreement shall come to an end upon the expiry of its Term and/or the renewal period thereof.

5. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

5.1 The Parties shall endeavour to settle any dispute arising in connection with the interpretation, performance or termination of this Agreement, or otherwise in connection with this Agreement, through friendly consultations and negotiations.
