Whereas Sir syed College established in 1967 to impart moral and liberal education to the backward minority communities of North Malabar region of Kerala; the college started functioning as a junior college under the University of Kerala in 1967. Subsequently it came under the University of Calicut in 1968 and under the Kannur University in 1996. The college is reaccredited by NAAC during the year 2017. College has completed 50 years of its glorious service and is today one of the biggest post graduate institutions under Kannur University. The college at present offers 13 Under Graduate and 4

Post Graduate programmes. Currently college is running 9 certificate courses in various departments like Organic farming techniques, Remote Sensing and GIS in Natural Resource Management, Reproductive health and Parenting and Computational Chemistry. Botany and Chemistry departments are the research centers where Post Doctoral Fellow, research guides and research scholars engaged in various research studies. Apart from this College offers coaching class for entry in various government services and National and State Eligibility Test (NET, SET) for minority students. College has set up a career guidance and counseling cell that offers various career guidance and counseling programs to the students. Students Employability Enhance Centre (SEEC), facilitate the student for gaining employment from entry level jobs to civil services categories. Through SEEC students are exposed to the various requirements like English language enhancement, business communication, Aptitude test etc. which enable them to get better career. The computer centre is functioning in the college to provide computer training for the staff and students. Counseling centre, Parent Teacher Association, Discipline committee, Grievance Redressal Cell, Alumni Association, Hostel facilities for boys and Girls, Canteen, College co operative society and NCC are all play better roll to fulfill the mission of college. Tutorial system provides opportunity for the close contact between staff and students. NSS aims to provide opportunities to the students to acquire valuable practical experience through social services. Sports council, Culture form, Arts form, Science form, Research forms are also established to create awareness and interest among the students. Ladies Association of Sir Syed (LASS) aims to uplift social and mental status of girl students and also to ensure gender justice in campus. Social Service Wing (SSW) aims to accelerate use of scientific knowledge for rural development and over all enhancements to lives and livelihoods of communities inhabiting near by the college. It conducts different educational and training program for women and school students, as well as promoting women's group to empower them and to live self determinedly. SSW mainly focuses on encouragement of organic agriculture for food security at Muiyam village and The Disha- Little Scholar Program for 7th standard students of Thaliparamba municipality. Various clubs like Boomithra Sena, Harithakam farm club, Forestry club, Tourism club, Entrepreneur ship club, Film /Media club are also functioning for boost up students interest.

LIFE STOCK MANAGEMENT TRAINING CENTRE (LMTC) OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY DEPARTMENT, KANNUR DISTRICT

Life Stock Management Training Centre (LMTC) Kannur, under Animal Husbandry department of Kerala government, functions as an institution to train the stakeholders of Kannur, Kasargod, Kozhikode and Wayanad district to help the people to find self employment in the concerned area. The institution provides training and technical support to farmers in scientific management and rearing of animal folk in association with various departments, institutions and organizations. Major aims of Animal Husbandry department are to design attractive scheme and projects for the sustainability of the traditional cattle/ animal farmers; implementation of innovative techniques coming up from research laboratories and institutions to the field for the perfect utilization of all possibilities from animal and bird farming. 

And

The **Sir Syed College, Taliparamba (Second Party)** having its office at Karimbam, Taliparamba, Kannur (India) which expression shall unless repugnant to the context of meaning thereof include its successors and permitted assignees.

Brief Description of MVR Institute of Life Science & Research Studies & MVR Snake Park and Zoo

Established in 2022, ***MVR Institute of Life Science and Research Studies*** is a Life Science Education and research institution located on the campus of the MVR institution at Pappinisseri, Kannur, Kerala. The Institute brings together leading experts from a variety of life science disciplines, working with a range of innovation-driven education models and cutting-edge research tools, to accelerate the student's skills that will broaden the understanding of the

basic processes of life, which will ignite, inspire and innovate the young minds to build their future.

We teach students with skills and strategies to renew themselves through inquiry, self-assessment, evaluation, and thereby building their future.

MVR Snake Park & Zoo, Parassinikkadavu is a small category zoo, recognized by Central Zoo Authority functioning under Pappinisseri Visha Chikilsa Kendram. The ex-minister and philanthropist Sri. M. V. Raghavan is the founder of the organization. It is the only zoo in Malabar area where people can visit and get education about few wildlife species especially snakes. It houses 33 species of animals including mammals, birds and reptiles. This is a major tourist attraction in Kannur district where more than five lakh visitors visits the place annually. It is a major research centre also where various research projects are being carried out.

Whereas Sir Syed College Taliparamba, one of the oldest higher education institutions in Kerala named after Sir Syed Ahmed Khan was established in 1967 by a group of educational visionaries of Kannur under Cannanore District Muslim Educational Association (CDMEA). The college was started as a Junior College under the University of Kerala. In 1968, it came under the University of Calicut and later under the Kannur University since 1996. The college offers academic programmes from undergraduate to research level in Arts, Science and Commerce streams. The college offers 14 Under Graduate programmes in Botany, Chemistry, Forestry, Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Zoology, Arabic, Economics, Functional English, History, Malayalam, Commerce and Multimedia & Communication. 5 Post Graduate programmes are offered in Botany, Chemistry, Physics, Arabic and Commerce. 3 departments: Botany, Chemistry and Commerce are research centres with 13 research guides. Thirteen scholars have been awarded Ph.D from these research centres so far. Many teachers are engaged in minor and major research projects funded by various agencies. The members of the faculty have contributed extensively to literatures in their respective fields. The Publication division of the college publishes the research journal, SEARCH. The college boasts of an extensive library with more than 41000 books, 25 research journals and INFLIBNET facility. The other facilities offered by the college include Sir Syed IT Centre, Career Guidance and Counselling Cell, Photostat Centre, Gymnasium, Health Club, Sports Pavilion, Ladies Retreat room, Canteen, Botanical garden,

Second Party will be responsible for the following areas:

- Joint organization of Value Added Courses, Short Term Courses, Professional Development Programmes, Orientation Programmes, Conferences, Seminars, Workshops, Webinars by utilizing available resources and other resource sharing
- Internship, field trip, lab visit programs.

3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

The financial arrangement for the co-operative activities undertaken within the framework of this MoU shall be mutually agreed upon by both the Parties on a case-to-case basis, subject to the availability of funds and resources.

4. REPRESENTATION AND WARRANTY

Each Party to this MoU represents that the execution and performance of this MoU is not contrary to any rule, law, statute, internal policy, or any other such order or rule by which such Party is bound.

5. PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS/ OWNERSHIP

Each party will protect, its territory, intellectual property rights of the other party in force in their respective areas. All copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software or intellectual property rights of the documents produced in support of any activity under this MoU shall remain with the Party owning it.

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed during the course of this MoU shall be decided through a separate project specific agreement.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. Confidential information includes all communication of information disclosed in

documentary or tangible form between the Parties, including oral, written and machine-readable form, pertaining to the above which is indicated as confidential. In the case of such information disclosed orally or visually, the Disclosing Party shall confirm in writing the fact and general nature of each disclosure within (30) days after it is made

- b. Confidential information includes information:
 - 1. Disclosed by, or on behalf of, the Disclosing Party to the Receiving Party.
 - 2. Otherwise learned or ascertained by the Receiving party from inspection and/or evaluation of sample(s) identified by the Disclosing party as confidential and provided to the Receiving party by or on behalf of the Disclosing Party (sample(s)) and/or.
 - 3. Otherwise learned or ascertained by the Receiving Party from the Disclosing Party.
- c. The Receiving Party will not disclose confidential information of the Disclosing Party to any other person and use at least the same degree of care to maintain the Information confidential as receiving party uses in maintaining as confidential its own confidential Information, but always at least a reasonable degree of care; due diligence will be taken by both the parties in maintenance of confidential information.
- d. The Receiving Party will use the confidential information only for the above mentioned purpose.
- e. The Receiving Party, will restrict disclosure of the confidential information of the Disclosing Party solely to those employees, subsidiaries, parent and affiliated companies of Receiving Party having a need to know such Information in order to accomplish the purpose stated above.
- f. This MoU imposes no obligation on Receiving Party with respect to any portion of the confidential information received from Disclosing Party which:
 - i. Was known to Receiving Party prior to disclosure by Disclosing Party.
 - ii. Is lawfully obtained by Receiving Party from a third party under no obligation of confidentiality,
 - iii. Is, or becomes, generally known or publicly available other than by unauthorized disclosure, is independently developed by Receiving Party.
 - iv. Is disclosed by Disclosing Party to a third party without a duty of confidentiality on the third party.
 - v. Is required by law or decree.
- g. The confidential information shall remain the sole property of the Disclosing Party.
- h. The obligation of non-disclosure of confidential information shall survive for 3 years

after expiry/termination of this MoU.

7. SUSPENSION

Each party reserves the rights for reasons of national security, national interest, public order or public health to suspend temporarily either in whole or in part the implementation of this MoU. The suspension shall take effect immediately after written notification has been given to the other party through diplomatic channels.

8. REVISION, MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENT

Either Party may request in writing a revision, modification or amendment of all or any part of this MoU. Any revision, modification or amendment agreed to by the parties shall be reflected in writing and shall form part of this MoU. Such revision, modification or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by parties.

9. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

The MoU is not intended to create any legal obligations between the Parties. Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/ or implementation and / or applicable to any of the provisions of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and / or negotiation between the Parties, without reference to any third party or international tribunal.

The MoU shall be governed and constructed in accordance with the Laws of India. The parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of Kannur Court in Kerala in connection with any dispute between the Parties under the MoU.

In case any disputes arise in implementing the MoU, these shall be resolved by mutual consultation.

10. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

The MoU shall commence from the Effective Date and shall continue for a period of 10 years from the Effective Date (hereafter referred to as "Term"). Thereafter, both parties shall review the status of this co-operation and may extend the Term on such conditions as mutually

agreed upon.

Not with standing the 10 paragraph mentioned above, either party may terminate this MoU by notifying the other Party in writing at least Six (6) months in advance of such termination.

10.1 Unless otherwise agreed upon by the Parties, the termination of this MoU shall not affect the implementation of the on-going activities and/or programmes, which have been agreed upon before the date of the termination of the MoU.

11. SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT (SPOC)

Each party shall designate a person or office to serve as liaison for implementing this MoU. The liaison/ SPOC may change from time to time upon notice given to the other party in writing pursuant to this MoU.



- (a) The occurrence of any such event of force majeure; and
- (b) Resume its responsibilities on the cessation of such force majeure event.



14. MISCELLANEOUS

Neither party shall use or publicize the MoU in such a manner as to cause any disrepute to the other party and shall not make any statement relevant to this MoU which may reasonably be considered to be misleading.

If any doubt arises as to the interpretation of the provisions of this Agreement or as to matters not provided therein, the parties to this Agreement shall consult with each other for each instance and resolve such doubts in good faith.

In case of dispute or difference arising out of, or in connection with, this MoU; the same shall be settled through mutual discussions between MVR Institute of Life Science & Research Studies and Sir Syed College, Taliparamba.
