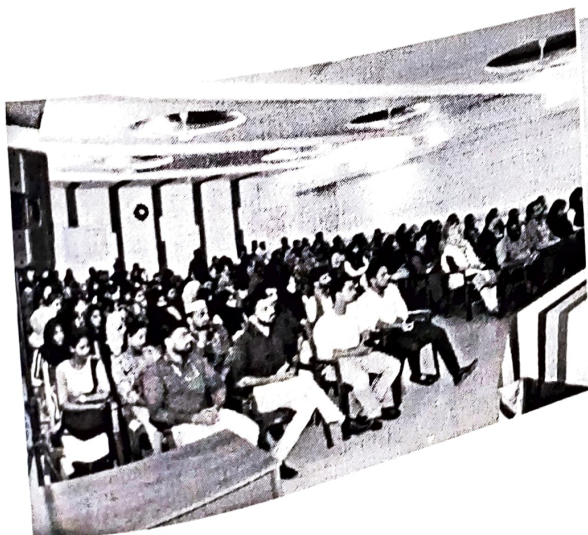
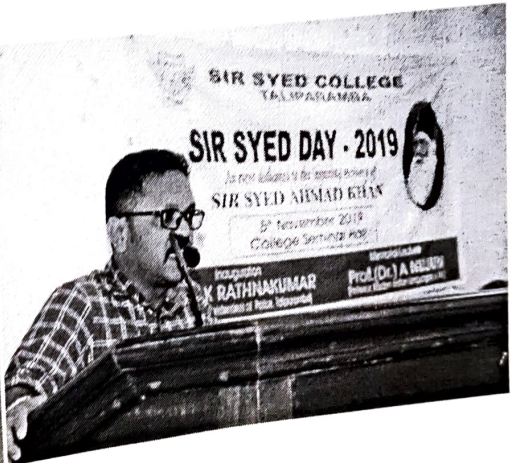
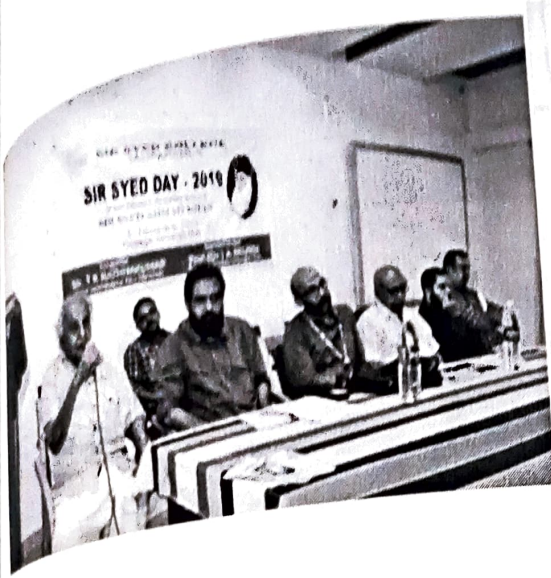
In the year 1862 Sir Syed Ahmad Khan founded the Sir Syed College in Talipkavayam.
