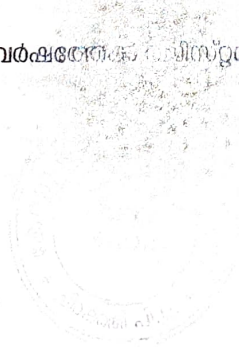

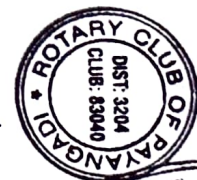



AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made on this 05th day of June, 2023 by and between:

WILDLIFE TRUST OF INDIA, a trust established on 16- November- 1998 under the Indian Trust Act, 1882, (Registration no. DIT (E)/98-99/W/101/98/621 of Section 12 (A) of Income Tax Act) having its office in Noida (hereinafter referred to as 'WTI' which shall include its successors and permitted assigns) which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators and permitted assigns of the FIRST PART

AND

SIR SYED COLLEGE, TALIPARAMBA established in 1967 under the UGC act (hereinafter referred to as 'COLLEGE' which shall include its successors and permitted assigns) which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators and assigns of the SECOND PART.

WTI and **COLLEGE** are hereinafter referred collectively as "Parties" and individually as "Party"

WHEREAS:

1. **WTI** and the **COLLEGE** would like to cooperate with each other in conservation education related activities in Kerala.
2. **Wildlife Trust of India (WTI)** is a leading Indian nature conservation organisation committed to the service of nature. Its mission is to conserve wildlife and its habitat and to work for the welfare of individual wild animals, in partnership with communities and governments. WTI's team of 150 dedicated professionals work towards achieving its vision of a secure natural heritage of India, in six priority landscapes, knit holistically together by nine key strategies or Big Ideas.
3. **Sir Syed College, Taliparamba** has long history of conservation education. The **COLLEGE** offers programmes from UG to PhD. The **COLLEGE** has been in the fore front of creating conservation awareness especially in the field of mangroves sacred groves and water, energy and waste management. The departments of Botany, Zoology & Forestry, and Bhoomithrasena has been associating with the activities of WTI in Kannur district over the last decade through its Kannur Kandal Project.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS

WTI and the **COLLEGE** with due endorsement from the Principal of the institution, desire to cooperate with each other in creating and spreading knowledge on nature conservation in Kerala.

1. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

- 1.1. During the term and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Parties agree to partner with each other in creating and spreading knowledge on nature conservation in Kerala.

2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

WTI

- 2.1. WTI shall provide guidance and field support to the BSc/MSc students to fulfil their dissertation projects of the COLLEGE through its various ongoing projects in Kerala on need to need basis.
- 2.2. WTI shall provide students with available facilities including library, Interpretation centre facility and mangrove habitats secured by WTI, land operated through its Kannur Kandal Project and other conservation projects / initiatives run by WTI in Kerala
- 2.3. The bonafide students of the COLLEGE can also intern with WTI depending on the availability of positions and requirement.

COLLEGE

- 2.4. The COLLEGE shall provide access to their facilities and resources (Labs, library, expert support for taxonomical identification etc) on case to case basis to WTI; with prior consent from the respective Head of the Departments.
- 2.5. The Head of the COLLEGE has all the right to take the final decision on the terms of access to the researchers.

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

- 3.1. The project thesis and any publication prepared by bonafide students of the COLLEGE, shall acknowledge WTI, and the Project of WTI through which the study is executed and the partner agency of the program.
- 3.2. The project thesis and any publication prepared by bonafide candidates of the WTI, shall acknowledge the COLLEGE and provide appropriate authorship to the COLLEGE personnel involved in the project. The publications shall also provide appropriate authorship to the WTI personnel involved in the project.
- 3.3. These shall be decided in mutual consent of WTI and the COLLEGE before the initiation of any project.
- 3.4. The COLLEGE shall provide one copy of the research report to WTI and WTI shall provide one copy of the research project done at the COLLEGE by the bonafide candidate of WTI.

4. TERM & TERMINATION

- 4.1. This Agreement shall be effective from 05th June 2023 and shall be valid for a period of twenty-four months *i.e.* till 04th June 2025.
- 4.2. The term of this Agreement may be further extended for such period and on such terms as the Parties may mutually decide in writing. This Agreement shall come to an end upon the expiry of its Term and/or the renewal period thereof.

5. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 5.1 The Parties shall endeavour to settle any dispute arising in connection with the interpretation, performance or termination of this Agreement, or otherwise in connection with this Agreement, through friendly consultations and negotiations.
