



Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Between

Department of Arabic W.M.O Arts & Science College, Muttil, Wayanad & Department of Arabic Sir Syed College, Taliparamba, Kannur

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is made on February 1, 2020, between the Department of Arabic, W.M.O. Arts & Science College, Muttil, Wayanad, and the Department of Arabic, Sir Syed College, Taliparamba, Kannur, and may be amended only by written agreement signed by each of the parties involved.

The general objectives of this memorandum of understanding (MoU) are to ignite and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programmes that serve to enhance the intellectual and cultural development of both departments. Thus, the Department of Arabic, W.M.O. Arts & Science College, Muttil, Wayanad, and the Department of Arabic, Sir Syed College, Taliparamba, Kannur, have agreed to support their mutual interests in the field of International conferences, workshops, FDP, and other academic exchange programmes.

The two parties HEREBY agree to establish collaboration according to the terms and conditions set out in the article following hereunder.

Field of Cooperation

Teacher Training and Professional Development: The departments can organise joint workshops, seminars, and training sessions for Arabic language instructors.

Exchange Programmes: Establishing exchange programmes between the two departments can provide opportunities for students and faculty members to immerse themselves in Arabic-speaking environments and gain firsthand experience of the language and culture.

Conduct study camps and workshops that facilitate learning activities.

Research and Publications: The departments can encourage collaboration in research and scholarly publications. Faculty members can engage in joint research projects, co-author articles, and present their findings at conferences. Collaborative research can contribute to the advancement of Arabic linguistics, literature, and cultural studies.

Resource Sharing: The departments can collaborate on resource sharing, such as libraries, multimedia materials, online resources, and language learning technologies. This can expand the available resources for students and faculty members, making it easier to access authentic Arabic language materials and tools for teaching and learning.

Conduct field trips for the faculty development programme in India and aboard

The aim of the MoU shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaborations, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both parties.

The Host party agrees to assist in the seeking of appropriate housing to supply work space, a library, and technical facilities as appropriate.

In the implementation of specific cooperative programmes, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects, including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party, will be negotiated, mutually agreed upon, and formalised in writing, prior to the commencement of the programme.

Agree to the shared use of facilities, including classrooms, offices, and library facilities that reduces operating costs and promotes collaboration among students, faculty, staff, and community members for programme success.

Validation period of this MoU

This MoU shall be valid for a period of three years from the execution of the same, unless the parties mutually agree in writing to extend the same.

This MoU can be terminated by either party upon written notice of not less than ninety (90) days.


