Department of History, Sir Syed College has hosted 7th ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL KERALA HISTORY CONFERENCE from 15th to 17th Nov 2019 in Association with IDis-19 and Sahithya Pravarthaka C.S Ltd Kottayam at College Auditorium.

DAY 1

The Inaugural Session of 7th ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL KERALA HISTORY CONFERENCE was conducted on 15th Nov 2019 at College Auditorium at 10.00AM. Dr. P T Abdul Azees, Principal of Sir Syed College delivered Welcome speech and Sri Mahamood Allamkulam , Secretary of CDMEA delivered presidential address. Prof. MGS Narayanan, President of KHC delivered his introductory remarks and was inaugurated by Prof. Ravi A Palat, Binghamton University, New york and talked on the topic “*History and Spatial reconsignation: some preliminary considerations.*”
