ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The curriculum for the programs offered at the institution is designed by the university. The college strictly follows this curriculum and develops academic plans for its implementation. Feedback from teachers and students is collected periodically and reported to authorities through bodies such as the Board of Studies, Board of Examinations, Academic Council members, Senate members, and other committees. Feedback on the implementation of the curriculum is gathered and appropriate actions are taken accordingly.

Based on the feedback collected from various stakeholders, especially the students, the following actions were implemented at both the college and department levels.

2018-19

- Remedial classes were arranged for weak students at the end of each semester to help them prepare for exams.
- ➤ A cleaning drive was conducted to ensure a dust-free campus.
- ➤ Decided to make the question bank available on the college website.

> <u>2019-20</u>

- ➤ Online classes were organized during COVID-19 lockdown, and it was decided to make resources available online.
- ➤ A special timetable was created to ensure the regular operation of online classes.
- ➤ Decided to establish a departmental library for each department where one had not yet been created.

- ➤ All students are provided with a G Suite account linked to their institutional email, enabling access to Google Classroom.
- ➤ Microscopes were purchased for the Botany lab to allow students to work simultaneously.
- ➤ Wheelchairs have been acquired and are available at the college to facilitate easy movement for physically challenged students.

> 2020-21

- Arrangements were made to conduct classes in a blended mode, and it was decided to implement the MOODLE LMS system for learning management.
- ➤ With the assistance of the PTA, mobile phones were distributed to students who did not have the devices needed to attend online classes.
- ➤ Each department organized an academic national and international seminar titled "Doctrina" in online zoom platform

2021-22

- The chemistry department lab was renovated to include additional equipment and expanded working space.
- The practice of having multiple teachers handle one subject has been discontinued, and now each subject is assigned to a single teacher only.
- Classroom infrastructure was enhanced by installing whiteboards, additional fans, and more lighting with the support of P.T.A.

- Library has been renovated with advanced facilities.
- An audiovisual theater and media lab were constructed for BJMC students.
- A Braille facility was introduced for students with disabilities at college library
