THE KERALA STATE BIODIVERSITY BOARD REQUIRES “DISTRICT CO-ORDINATOR” IN KASARAGOD DISTRICT.

Kerala State Biodiversity Board is involved in conservation of biodiversity, its sustainable use and equitable sharing of benefits arising out of its commercial use with the help of Biodiversity Management Committees and the Public. District Co-ordinator of Kerala State Biodiversity Board is to liaise with BMC's, general public, other Departments and different agencies in achieving these objectives. The post will be purely on temporary contract basis and initially for a period of one year. The period may be extended for one more year on the basis of performance.

1. **Name of Post** : **District Co-ordinator- Kasaragod district (1 Post)**
2. **Consolidated Emoluments:** Rs.22,290/- per month.
3. **Age Limit** : Below 56 Years.
4. **Essential Qualification** : M.Sc in any Biological Sciences /Life Sciences / Environmental Sciences from a recognized University
5. **Desirable** : 1. Ph.D /M.Phil Degree in the above mentioned fields.
2. Minimum 2 years experience in activities related to environment/ biodiversity conservation.
